



User manual – Emfo Covers

Before pulling the covers, first make sure that the ailerons are in neutral. Otherwise there is a risk that your covers are ripped. The first time you have to adjust the rubber lines, so that they fit. The rubber lines below the wings are used for tightening the covers when the glider is parked outside and in windy conditions. The loops from below of the wing- och stabiliser covers can be used for hanging the covers for drying.



- Check that all rudders are in the neutral.
- Pull on the wing covers first, then adjust the rubber lines.
- Pull on the canopy cover, adjust the rubber lines.
- Pull on the stabiliser cover.
- Pull on the fin and side rudder cover.
- Finally, if you have any, apply the body cover.
- The covers are washable in 40°C, 104F.
- Never keep the covers in the sack if they are wet, there is a risk for molding.
- Don't forget to remove the covers before flying
- Parking not your glider under tree That is not for good for the covers
